Mineral Scan	\$95.00
Description: Groundwater is stored in various rock and sediment formations. The type of rock or sediment formation is a major factor in determining the overall quality of your water. The mineral scan screens for minerals commonly found in groundwater, as well as metals commonly found in landfills and dumps.	
<i>Test Parameters</i> : Aluminum, Barium, Beryllium, Boron, Cadmium, Calcium, Chromium, Cobalt, Copper, Iron, Lithium, Magnesium, Manganese, Molybdenum, Nickel, Phosphorus, Potassium, Silicon, Silver, Sodium, Strontium, Vanadium, and Zinc.	

Volatile Organic Compounds*

Total Volatile Organic Chemical Test (VOC)	\$149.00
Description: VOC's are a group of commonly used chemicals that evaporate, or volatilize, when exposed to air. This test is a screening for the most common industrial contaminants and gasoline. *EPA recommends testing every 5-10 years.	
<i>Test Parameters</i> : Petroleum Volatile Organic Chemicals (PVO), trichloroethylene (TCE), trichloroethane, benzene, toluene, xylenes, plus more (total of 53 compounds).	

*All VOC testing requires special bottles. Some tests can be time sensitive and require special shipping instructions.

Pesticide*

Triazine Screen	\$89.00
Description: Screening for pesticides used in agriculture. Strongly recommended if nitrate is present in your water. NOTE: A triazine screen is an approximate test.	
<i>Test Parameters</i> : Atrazine and several chemicals it breaks down into.	
Pesticide	\$220.00
Description: Screening for the most commonly used pesticides and herbicides for both agriculture and household. Strongly recommended if nitrate is present in your water.	
<i>Test Parameters</i> : Atrazine, Alachlor, Cyanazine, Simazine, Butylate, Prometon, Metolachlor, plus more (total of 19 compounds).
